

“Sailor Suit”

for 16.5 inch Teddy Bear such as Sunkid’s Janine



Knitted Measurements Top

Lengths 6 inches, width 7.5 inches. Length of sleeves 2.0 inches.

Knitted Measurements Shorts

Lengths 6 inches, width 7.1/4 inches.

You will need

About 3 ounces of sport yarn or sock yarn in white and about 1 1/2 ounce of leftover marine. The range of needle sizes is 3.5 mm (US 4).

Stitch Pattern

Knit one row and purl one row. Repeat these two rows, knitting all right-side rows and purling all wrong-side rows.

Ribbing on top of shorts: knit 1, purl 1

Back/Front Sailor Top

Cast on 50 stitches in marine. Knit 6 rows according to the stitch pattern above, starting with your first row in purl.

Continue in white. Decrease 3 x 1 stitches on both sides every 6th row. Continue until you reach a height of 3 1/4 inches.

Shape Armhole

Bind off 7 stitches on both sides. Bind off 3 x 1 stitches in every 4th row. Bind of 3 x 1 every 2nd row.

Shape Neck

Once you reach a height of 4 1/4 inches bind off the middle 8 stitches. At neck edge every other row bind off 1 x 2 stitches.

Knit 6 more rows with the remaining 2 stitches on both sides, and then bind off.

Work the back in the same fashion.

Sleeves

Cast on 36 stitches in marine. Knit 6 rows according to the stitch pattern above, starting with your first row in purl.

Continue in white until you reach a height of 2 inches. Bind off 7 stitches on both sides. In the beginning of every 4th row bind of 4 x 1 stitches. Bind off all stitches at a height of 4 inches.

Work the second sleeve in the same fashion.

Collar

Cast on 42 stitches in white and knit 14 rows according to the stitch pattern. For the neck bind off the middle 8 stitches. On the inner edge Bind off 1 x 2 stitches on both sides. Continue sides separately. Increase at the **inner edge** 5 x 1 in every second row and 5 x 1 stitches in every 6th row. At the same time bind off at the **outer edge** in every 4th row 3 x 1 stitches and in every 2nd row bind off 1 stitch until there are 2 stitches remaining. Bind off the remaining 2 stitches.

Finish off the collar in marine with two rows of single crochet stitches followed by one row of “Crab Stitches” (reverse single crochet). To keep the collar in place crochet a loop of 8 slip stitches and one row of single crochet stitch and slip the ends of the collar thru.

Finishing

Sew shoulder and side seams. Set in sleeves. Around the neck finish off in marine with one row of single crochet stitches followed by one row of “Crab Stitches” (reverse single crochet).

Following the graph below duplicate stitch a sailboat in the middle of the front using marine yarn.



Sailor Shorts

Pant leg Left/Right

Cast on 48 stitches in marine. Knit 6 rows according to the stitch pattern above, starting with your first row in purl.

Continue in white until you reach a height of 2 inches. Bind off 4 stitches on each side. Continue with the remaining stitches. Decrease 3 x 1 stitch on each side after every 6th row. When you reach a height of 3 inches change to marine yarn and knit 8 rows for the ribbing. Bind off all stitches in the pattern they occur.

Work the other pant leg in the same fashion.

Finishing

Sew leg seams and shorts together.
