

## “You Are No. 1” Jersey for 13 inch Teddy Bear such as Sunkid’s Irina



### Knitted Measurements

Lengths 5 inches, width 5.5 inches. Length of sleeves 1.75 inches.

### You will need

Some leftover (approx. 1 1/2 ounces) sport yarn or sock yarn in a color that suits your bear. A small amount of yarn in a contrasting colour for the “1” in Duplicate Stitch. The range of needle sizes is 3.5 mm (US 4). You need a set of double-pointed needles, for knitting in the round. I learned to use a set of 5 (rather than 4) needles. I find it easier with 5 needles when a small amount of stitches is required such as for the sleeves. Try it out

---

### Back/Front

The sweater is knitted in the round. Cast on 64 stitches. Divide stitches evenly over three or four needles. Join, taking care not to twist stitches on needles.

#### Ribbing:

Knit 1 (entering the needle in the back of the stitch), purl 1, and repeat over 5 rows.

**Continue** after the ribbing with purl in the back and knit stitch in the front till you reach 2 ¼ inch height.

Bind off 3 stitches for the armhole, knit 28 stitches for the front, bind off 3 stitches and finish off the back (30 stitches).

**Continue with the front** (28 stitches wide) until a total height of 3 1/2 inches. Bind off the middle 7 stitches in the front.

### Shape Neck Front

At neck edge: every other row bind off 2 stitches, than 1 stitch, continue until armhole measures 2.3/4 inches.

Bind off all remaining stitches for the shoulder.

Finish the other side in the same fashion.

**Continue with the back** until a total height of 4 inches. Bind off the middle 8 stitches.

### Shape Neck Back

At neck edge: every other row bind off 2 x 2 stitches, than 1 stitch, continue until armhole measures the same as front armhole and bind off all remaining stitches for the shoulder.

### Sleeves

Cast on 28 stitches in the round. Continue with knit stitch.

In the beginning of every second row increase by one stitch. Repeat increase 7 times (until 35 stitches).

Bind off loosely when you reach a total height of 2 inches.

### Finishing

Sew shoulder seams. Set in sleeves.

### Neckband.

Pick up 53 stitches knitting 5 rounds as described under ribbing. Bind off loosely.

### Embroidery

Following the graph below duplicate stitch a “1” in the middle of the front using contrasting color of yarn.
